The UI could use some work, though. I had to Google how to set presets for the AM/FM radio. You need to be in AUTO2, then hit the < arrow to bring out the preset menu, then hold the preset number until you see it say Preset 12 or whatever on the screen. Not super intuitive. The processor also feels a tad slow, but the price is reasonable for all you get. Great installation instructions, great sound, responsive touch screen. I'm no audiophile, but I'm very happy with the Kenwood DMX4710S. Excellent sound, reasonably responsive touchscreen, and easy installation. What I don't love: the mic is not great. Siri understands me, but people receiving phone calls while driving have had trouble. Three out of maybe 25 times I plugged in my iPhone and CarPlay failed to connect for some reason. Not sure if it's the head unit, phone, or cable. Unplugging and plugging back in solved it

Volume control and next song are easy, but if you want to mute, it is two menus away. But you can press the pause button. You cannot adjust the treble and bass on the head unit. You also can't use advanced sound adjustments while using Apple Music. With wider phones like the iPhone 15 Max, it's a tight squeeze. Depending on position, it hugs the power or the volume button, which is a problem. The audio from the app is extremely bad and LOW. Adjusting source volume did nothing. The Radio is super loud, but I maxed out the volume in the app and still couldn't hear it. You cannot view text messages, and the audio to speak them usually misses a few words. The phone falls out of the holder almost instantly. You can't use cord and Bluetooth simultaneously; you have use the menu to switch between the two. (It usually doesn't switch); You must use the app to preset radio stations. Anything you do on the radio causes your phone to switch to the app. You must remove face plate to move the phone holder.

This thing fits perfectly in the original single-DIN slot, boots up super quick, has a nice bright clear screen, and great sound quality, and is an excellent way to update your older car. Highly recommended! Added a flush-mounted USB port from Amazon to plug into the back of the radio for wired Apple CarPlay. The connector is exactly the same as Kenwood, so I didn't even have to rewire it.
